

IMPORTANT FURTHER GUEST INFORMATION

DIRECTIONS TO BODYSGALLEN HALL

Take the A55 and exit at Junction 19, and then follow the A470 towards Llandudno. The hotel is approximately two miles on the right. The nearest train station is Llandudno Junction, 2 miles from the hotel where guests can be met by Taxi (please advise of your arrival time). There are regular trains from London Euston and the journey takes three hours by direct train. There are also regular trains from the north west of England.

Arrival and Departure

Rooms are available for guests' arrival from **2.00pm**. Checkout time is by **12 noon** on the day of departure. Should guests require early occupation or late departure, please contact our Reception Manager who will endeavour to make the necessary arrangements. (A charge may be levied for this).

We provide 24 hour complimentary parking; we also offer valet parking for those guests wishing to arrive at the front door of the hotel. A car parked on behalf of our guests is at the liability of the client.

Complimentary **WIFI** access is available in nearly all bedrooms, but **not** in the restaurants and public rooms of the Main Hall.

Bodysgallen Hall is a **NON-SMOKING HOTEL**, including all public rooms, bedrooms and suites. A deep cleaning charge of £100.00 will be levied should traces of tobacco be evident in your bedroom or suite.

We welcome children over the age of **6** years at Bodysgallen Hall, and over **8** years in the Bodysgallen Spa at set swimming times.

Dogs are welcomed by prior arrangement in some of the Cottage Suites except in the bedrooms, two small dogs or one larger dog, and may be walked in the park and woods, but not please in the garden. Damage to rooms or injury to livestock will be charged for. We particularly ask that dogs should not be allowed onto the beds, sofas and armchairs. Only guide dogs are welcomed in the Hall.

Sky News, Sky One, Sky Sports 1, and 2 are available in the main house and in nearly all of the cottage suites.

The Spa at Bodysgallen Hall

Children of residents, between the ages of **8** and **16**, may use Bodysgallen Spa between the hours of 10.00am – 11.00am and 4.00pm – 5.00pm when accompanied by an adult residential guest.

BOOKING CONDITIONS FOR HOTEL AND SPA RESERVATIONS

We respectfully remind guests that a reservation constitutes a contract between themselves and Bodysgallen Hall.

Any reservation/s cancelled within 48 hours of the arrival date (or within two weeks for bookings of five rooms or more, or for overseas booking) is liable to be charged for unless we are able to re-let the accommodation to another guest. Any reservations made on our 'Late Rooms' offer must be paid for in full at the time of booking and are non-refundable.

A reservation for treatments made directly with the Spa constitutes a contract between clients and the Bodysgallen Spa. A 50% charge will be incurred for any treatment cancelled less than 24 hours prior to appointment, or if there is non-attendance at the time of the reserved treatment.

If treatment reservations are made directly with the Spa, independent of bedroom reservations, cancellations should be through the Spa Reception.

The hotel reserves the right to pre-authorise credit cards upon arrival.
